Summary/Action

Physical R/R with a large frame, good shoulders, and lots of room to add strength top to bottom. Gave off a "bat first" vibe during the tournament. Showed a very mature approach for a young 14 yr old and his efforts paid off with tons of solid contact. Swing mechanics and timing consistency require some polish but should see improvements as he grows and develops. Don't see a definite future position here but was intriguing behind the plate. Showed strong hands receiving the ball and worked hard to keep it in front. Lower half was a bit on the stiff side but if as he improves his flexibility, he will be able to effectively receive more pitches in the strike zone. Will need to grow into his power while maintaining his athleticism but could see this kid playing at the next level if he continues to grow.
