High slot, good leverage, stiff finish. Consistent speed, projectable.

Comments

He has to ease up sometimes to find the zone. When he cuts it loose he can throw the ball by hitters.

Arm Strength

Comments

Best tool. Good leverage. With his frame and build, should continue to improve.

Delivery

4 - Slightly Above Average

Comments

Tall at balance point, short strider, cuts off his finish. Lands on line with tall finish. He's still young and

learning how to sync his delivery.

Control

4 - Slightly Above Average

Comments

He's around the plate but not sure if he always knows where it's going. However, with his athleticism and good direction he finds enough strikes presently.

Fastball

5 - Above Average

Comments

Best tool. 4 seamer with good carry and ride life up in the strike zone. Sharp plane and depth when out in front. (76-81)

Off Speed

3 - Average

Comments

Lacks feel to spin the ball. Soft shape and break to curve ball. It's still early and I am confident that when he learns how to spin the ball he will get better. (61-63)

PLAYER SUMMARY

Summary/Action

Large frame, mound athlete with arm strength and projection. Still very early in his development, trying to figure out how to rhythm and repeat a delivery. However, shows nice potential. More thrower than pitcher at this junction, however, shows signs of long term potential. He will be an interesting one to follow.
