Feet

Quick and easy looking movements. Goes left/right w/ body control.

Hands

Comments

For age player shows makings of beginning to play through GBs like an advanced infielder.

Reactions

Feet and body move in tandem and remain under control.

Body Control

Player shows body control while underway in all directions.

Strength

Comments

Looks like his body will mature with room for strength development. Still lean, should focus on maintaining lean type muscle development.

Player looks to be a bit advanced along developmental scale but not nearly finished. Plenty of room for more gains.

BASEBALL SKILLS

Fielding

4 - Slightly Above Average

Comments

Hands, feet, body control all show coordination and an athletic ease when working. Receives ball bordering on an advanced way.

Range

Comments

Player has just adequate speed but first step quickness allows him a chance to stay at SS.

Running

Comments

For position, player is an adequate runner. His baserunning grades up, though, because of instincts and jumps that give him quality SB potential.

Arm Strength

Comments

Arm looks solid from SS now for age. Easy to see it growing into position as he matures and ages.

Arm Accuracy

4 - Slightly Above Average

Comments

Most throws are on-line, show feel for target. Throwing on run laterally is significant hurdle but that skill/feel usually is last to develop – very difficult play.

Hitting Ability

4 - Slightly Above Average

Comments

Really like hit approach. Believe it's just right. Looks like line drive approach, gap to gap. Player will definitely grow into some power. Must let it come naturally and not load up at this stage.

Power Potential

4 - Slightly Above Average

Comments

Player has type of pop in bat to make him a future 3, 5, or 6 type hitter in the batting order. Player has potential to bring bat quality and some pop to a line-up.

PLAYER SUMMARY

Really like this player's package. No huge tool to anchor around but shows a very good package of tools. Player will bring value to club in several ways; solid defense, quality bat with some extra base hit value, and advanced base running. Player should be a college player in future and depending on physical development has chance to interest some pro scouts.
