The path of the bat traveled through the zone reminiscent of Johnny Damon. He was able to work counts and control the zone. Currently, he has slightly above average power with more of the same in the future. He will be hit over power with lots of balls hit in the gaps for extra bases. In the field, I like the athleticism and instincts I saw while he played CF. He had proper routes taken along with good jumps on the ball off the bat. He made a great diving catch while also throwing out a runner trying to advance to third base. Overall, this is a solid player with skills both in the field and on the mound.
