## **PLAYER SUMMARY**

### **Summary/Action**

Future CF beyond High School with offensive and defensive skills. Line drive spray hitter with solid defense. Arm will be a plus. Continue long toss and get as many balls off the bat on defense during batting practice as possible. Everybody could improve hitting. Suggest up the middle/leftcenter approach. Recommend front toss from about 15 feet and go middle to left center. Also hitting off batting tee inside batting cage. Put ball on tee at top of the strike zone and try to hit line drives into the back of the cage. Drills are good but they need to be in addition to batting practice. Suggest no more than 10-12 swings each round in batting and get as many rounds as reasonable.. Very important in hitting is to see the ball out of the pitcher's hand until it hits the bat.
