## PLAYER SUMMARY

Tall, slender RHS with high waist, long arms/legs and projectable body. Some width in back and shoulders to carry more weight for strength gains future. Most FB with natural cut action away from RHH. Painted outside half well. CB 11-5 shape with occasional tight rotation snap action. Most D3/4 rolling action. Must keep ball over elbow and fingers over ball to maximize rotation on pitch. Turns body away from arm to 1B upon release. Must stay on line behind pitch when throwing and finish towards hitter. This will allow increase in velocity and sharpen CB also. Good chance to pitch beyond high school with minor mechanical adjustments and physical maturity.
