On line for the most part. Will rush and release ball high at times elevating ball over target.

Hitting Ability

4 - Slightly Above Average

Comments

Has a strong solid stroke naturally. Poor hitting mechanics take away from his ability to make consistent hard contact. Looks like he has fallen victim to poor launch angle talk. Too much swing and miss with what he is showing at plate. Needs to get back to line drive hard contact approach. If not he will not be the power hitter he is capable of becoming.

Power Potential

Comments

Big body with powerful swing all points to plus power potential. Will not get to this potential if he continues with current hitting mechanics.

PLAYER SUMMARY

Future power hitting corner infielder. Has ability to play either corner. Bat is primary tool here. Can pitch as well but needs to be on field everyday. Concerned about training he is receiving. Arm works well but overthrows and there is the risk of injury at a young age. As for hitting, concerned with upper cut type swing that makes it easy to pitch to him. Would recommend a change in instruction in order for him to reach his potential. This young man has a future in the game and poor instruction will limit him.
