Deliberate, upright stride; not a clogger

Best present tool; solid average major league arm strength, right now, and will show above average major league arm strength frequently - when he takes his time with his front shoulder and his feet under him; present ability with big upside

Comments

Gets upright and stands up, getting under the ball and throwing uphill; needs work on rhythm and fluidity; explosive; needs to take his time, in a hurry; correctable flaws; very projectable

Hitting Ability

Stance is a deep, slightly narrow, squat with his hands in tight at his neck; rolls open and uses shoulders to hit; on top of plate, with first move forward, up and to the left uppercut; muscles up; rarely gets bat head to the ball; clubber more than a hitter; needs extensive work with his approach

Strong; inconsistent leverage with below average extension; needs proper work
