PLAYER SUMMARY

Unassuming player at first glance, small for age, but carries large presence on the field and for his team. Constantly hustling and purposefully playing hard, shows ability to rise to competition level and stay a strong consistent player on both sides of the ball. Has good approach to hitting, using all field, squaring up balls and playing/executing in situational opportunities hitting behind the runner, driving in runs and giving himself up with a sacrifice when called on. Played larger than 5'1 frame in the outfield, ranging into gaps at both corner spots and showing arm strength and accuracy throwing out runners from RF in high pressure situations.
